## **Aerial Application of Pesticides and Fertilizers**

SACATON (June 4, 2021) -

The Gila River Indian Community (Community) has implemented a temporary moratorium for the aerial application of pesticides and fertilizers pursuant to the constitutional powers of the Community Council. The moratorium is effective immediately and will remain in effect until such time as appropriate regulations further governing these activities are approved by the Community.
